1.	Approval of minutes of 121 st meeting of the Senate	<p>Approved</p> <p>Some members raised an objection that the listing of the members present in the Minutes is not as per Seniority. The Chairman Senate informed the Senate that a committee is constituted is for finalizing the seniority list at all level and the list will be ready by next Senate.</p>
2	<p>Results of the II Semester of I year B.Tech and I year Integrated M.Sc, final semester of M.Tech/ MCA/ MBA, M.Sc.(Tech) and Makeup Examinations of the Academic Year 2021-22</p> <p>Dean Academic appraised that the Sub-committee met on 21st July 2022 and reviewed the results of all the programs and offered their suggestions, wherever required to the departments for possible revision of the results. Dean Academic presented the revised results received from the departments for approval. Dean Academic also informed the Senate that the results of I B.Tech (Biotechnology) were not submitted in time and hence could not be discussed in the Sub-committee meeting.</p> <p>All the results except the results of I B.Tech (Biotechnology) are passed by the senate. The Senate suggested that the results of I B.Tech (Biotechnology) may be reviewed by the Sub-committee and authorised the Chairman to approve the results after the review by Sub-Committee</p>	
3.	<p>Academic Calendar for AY 2022-23:</p> <p>The first semester of the Academic Year 2022-23 is commencing on 8th August 2022. The draft academic calendar of both the semesters (except for I year B.Tech and I year Integrated M.Sc.) of all the programs is placed before the Senate for approval.</p> <p>Senate approved the Academic Calendar for all programs (except I year B.Tech and I year Integrated M.Sc.)</p>	
4.	<p>Modified CO-PO mapping of B.Tech and M.Tech programs offered by the Department of Electrical Engineering:</p> <p>The NBA team that visited the Department of Electrical Engineering for accreditation has suggested modifications in the CO-PO articulation matrices of the B.Tech (EEE) program offered by the Department. As per the suggestion, the Department has modified the CO-PO articulation matrices of both B.Tech (EEE), M.Tech(PED), M.Tech(PSE) and M.Tech(SEG) programs offered by the Department. The curriculum of all these programs along with the modified CO-PO articulation matrices are placed before the Senate for approval.</p> <p>Senate approved the modified CO-PO mapping of B.Tech and M.Tech programs offered by the Department of Electrical Engineering</p>	
5.	<p>Proposal of Department of Mathematics to start a new PG Diploma program in Computational Mathematics and Finance</p>	



	<p>The Department of Mathematics has come out with a proposal to start a new PG Diploma program in Computational Mathematics and Finance.</p> <p>Senate has deferred this proposal. Senate has suggested the Department to come back with more details on the proposed program along with justification for starting this program</p>	
6.	<p>Proposal of Department of Humanities and Social Sciences to start a 2-year M.A. in English (Language & Literature):</p> <p>The Department of Humanities and Social Sciences is proposing to start a 2-year program of M.A. in English (Language & Linguistics).</p> <p>Senate has deferred this proposal. Senate has suggested the Department to focus on starting more courses in Foreign languages and Humanities to be offered to the UG, PG and Ph.D. programs.</p>	
7.	<p>Request from students who discontinued their B.Tech/ M.Tech for rejoining:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Setti Sumanth (Roll No. 187158) who joined B.Tech (CSE) in 2018 has completed I year but discontinued in the middle of III semester due to health and other family issues. He is now requesting permission to re-join and register for III semester. <p>The student has not cleared all the subjects in the first year and hence if he is given permission he needs to be repeat the first year, Moreover, he needs to be mapped to the new curriculum. According to the new curriculum, a student has to complete the course with six years from the date of admission. Mr. Sumanth got admission four years back in 2018 and will not be able to complete the B.Tech program within 6 years even if he is given permission for continuation.</p> <p>Senate has not approved the request.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Turpu Avinash (Roll No. 183175) who joined B.Tech (Mech) in 2018 discontinued after completing first semester due to a calamity in his family. He is now requesting to permit him to continue his studies. <p>The student has not cleared all the subjects in the first year and hence if he is given permission he needs to be repeat the first year, Moreover, he needs to be mapped to the new curriculum. According to the new curriculum, a student has to complete the course with six years from the date of admission. Mr. Avinash got admission four years back in 2018 and will not be able to complete the B.Tech program within 6 years even if he is given permission for continuation.</p> <p>Senate has not approved the request.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Sai Surya Musham (Roll No. CS21235) a student of M.Tech (CSIS) under self-finance scheme discontinued during the middle of first semester (November 2021) due to




		<p>health reasons. He is now requesting to re-join in this academic year.</p> <p>Senate has approved the request.</p>
8.	<p>Permission for PG students from other Institutions to pursue a part of dissertation work in our Institute</p> <p>Requests have come from few faculty members for permitting students from other Institutions to pursue a part of their dissertation work in our Institute. Since there are no guidelines regarding the pursuance of part of dissertation work of students from other Institutes in our Institute, this issue is placed before Senate for suggestions</p> <p>Senate referred this issue to the Academic Standing Committee and requested to Committee to come out with recommendations for discussion in the next Senate</p>	
9.	<p>Ph.D. Related Issues</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Under category (j) for admission to Part-time Ph.D. program, only Permanent faculty of Private Academic Institutions with NIRF ranking below 200 at least once in last five years are eligible. However, our Institution has MoU with some private Academic Institutions. As per the MoU, the permanent faculty members working in these Institutions can register for Part-time Ph.D. program irrespective of the Institution's NIRF ranking. Hence, the eligibility criteria under category (j) is proposed to be modified as: <p>“Permanent faculty of Private Academic Institutions with NIRF ranking below 200 at least once in last five years or Academic Institutions with which NITW has an MoU”</p> <p>Senate deferred this issue. Senate suggested that this issue may be discussed in the Academic Standing Committee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Department of Mechanical Engineering and DAC PG&R of Mechanical Engineering has recommended to change his supervisor of Mr. Rajat Jain (Roll No. 21MEFJ074), as the present supervisor Dr. Vijay Kumar Manupati is leaving the Institute. Dr. P. Subhash Chandra Bose, Professor, Department of Mechanical Engineering is recommended as the new supervisor. <p>Senate approved the Change of Guide.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering and DAC PG&R of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering has recommended to change of external supervisor of Mr. M Venu Madhav Rao (Roll No. 701951), as his external supervisor Dr. A Syam Sundar has superannuated from his services of RINL. Dr. R. Siva Kumar of RINL is recommended as the new external supervisor. <p>Senate approved the Change of Guide.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cancellation of Ph.D. admission of those who have not registered consecutively for two semesters or more. The list of



		<p>such research scholars was sent to the concerned Departments for recommendations. Based on the recommendations of the Departments, it is proposed to cancel the admissions of these students.</p> <p>Senate approved the cancellation of admission of the Ph.D. scholars who have not registered for two semesters or more.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To consider the applications of Ms. Vividha Kondba Landge (Roll No. 718154), Department of Chemical Engineering regarding sanction of Maternity leave w.e.f. 18.07.2022 for period of 6 months. She has already submitted her synopsis on 03.06.2022. <p>Senate approved the sanction of Maternity Leave to Ms. Vividha Kondba Langde. She has to submit her thesis with four and half months after joining back after Maternity leave.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Amendment to the rules related to the enrolment of teaching and non-teaching staff for part-time Ph.D.: As per the present rules (refer Appendix IV, rule 6-B-i) a member of non-teaching staff seeking permission to join PhD must hold a permanent post in the institute and must have a standing of at least three years service in the post. It is proposed to reduce the duration of holding the permanent post from three years to one year for enabling a non-teaching staff to enroll for Ph.D. The other conditions for getting enrolled to the PhD program remain same. <p>Senate differed this issue and suggested to discuss this issue in the Academic Standing Committee.</p>
10.	Issues for Ratification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. A Chandra Mohan, PhD scholar in the Department of Chemistry has been converted to Institute fellowship scheme and is being paid stipend from the date of his readmission. <p>Ratified</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr. Khirod Kumar Mahapatro, research scholar in the Department of Mechanical Engineering (Roll No. 718027), has been permitted to convert his Ph.D. registration from Full Time to Part time. <p>Ratified</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Punishments were given to the students caught doing different types of malpractices during the end-semester examinations and makeup examinations held in July 2022. <p>Ratified</p>
