The Chairman Senate gave the opening remarks and asked the Dean, Academic to proceed with the Agenda.

2023-128(A)-Senate-01	Semester Registration of Academically Weak Students

A large number of UG Engineering students are not promoted to their next higher semesters owing to backlog papers and low CGPA. These students have appealed to consider their promotions. The semester registration becomes a very challenging issue for them not only for clearing the backlogs but also completing a good number of courses for completion of B.Tech programme. The Dean, Academic has presented the statistics of these students in terms of their CGPA, credits earned and list of Backlogs etc.

The senate was requested to suggest a set of guidelines to help the academically weak students for continuing their semester registration in slow pace and enabling them to complete their programme in a reasonable time frame.

After a very detailed deliberation, the senate arrived at the following decision.

A student shall be allowed to continue for current semester registration whose

- (i) CGPA is 4.00 (Four) or above
- (ii) Completed the minimum credit requirement for promotion in the previous academic year
- (iii) Should not have more than 2 backlogs in the (n-2)th year

During the registration, faculty advisor will advise the students to register with following verification:

- a) All Backlog courses should be registered first,
- b) Then other courses of the current semester (Professional Electives, Open Electives, Laboratory courses, Summer Internship, Mandatory Non-Credit courses etc.) can be allowed for registration, provided that the total credit should not exceed 25 Credits
- c) These courses should not have prerequisites

The following students will be kept under Academic Probation, who have,

- i. CGPA less than 4.00 (Four),
- ii. Not completed the minimum credit requirement for promotion in the previous academic year.

The students will be kept under Academic Probation, i.e., allowed to register for only backlog courses, till they achieve 4.00 CGPA and clear the backlogs.
