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The Search Committee appointed by the Senate in its 140th Meeting has submitted its recommendation to the Chairman, Senate, which is placed in Annexure-1.

The Chairman, Senate has nominated the first name recommended by the Search Committee i.e. Prof. D V S S Sarma (Professor in EE) to serve as a Member, Board of Governors.

The Senate ratified the decision of Chairman, Senate.

2025-141-Senate-3	Fractal Courses
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The UG students admitted in the AY 2024-25 are required to complete two fractal courses each for 0.5 credits, one in 2nd year and the other in 3rd year. In order to encourage the students to learn the latest developments and exploit the opportunity of gaining learning experience from visiting faculty, adjunct faculty and through GIAN or SPARC programs, it is proposed that students may be allowed to take a maximum number of SIX fractal courses as and when arranged by the concerned Department or Institute right from 1st semester. If the student is able to acquire 3 credits through these fractal courses, one of the Open Elective/Professional Elective may be waived.

The Senate approved the proposal and suggested that GIAN or SPARC workshops may be conducted from 2.00 pm onwards to facilitate the students to participate in these workshops. The Senate also suggested that the students may be awarded one credit as per the norms of GIAN programs of one-week duration.

2025-141-Senate-7	Recommendation of the Semester Results to the Senate for approval
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In the recent semester results, it is observed that several corrections and requests are made for change of grades owing to omission or commission of entry of Marks. It is proposed to adopt the following steps to ensure publication of results accurately.

- a) Head (CDIS) is advised to facilitate the entry of all the components of evaluation in the ERP system, except for end-semester/Major examination marks, sufficiently in advance.*
- b) After entering the end-semester/Major examination marks by the faculty, GRADE shall be automatically generated by the ERP.*

- c) SUGC and SPGC will scrutinize the results of UG and PG/PhD programs respectively. If any discrepancies in the results are observed, the results will be referred back to the concerned faculty member for making the necessary corrections.*
- d) After satisfaction by the SUGC and SPGC, the results are recommended to Senate for its approval.*
- e) The Chairmen of SUGC and SPGC will present the results and analysis of the UG and PG programs respectively to the Senate.*
- f) Further, the Chairman, RPEC will present the details of PhD Scholar's progress for information of Senate.*

The Senate approved the proposal.

2025-141-Senate-5	Proposal for starting new Academic Programs
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Considering the Academic growth of the Institute and future direction towards industry needs it is proposed to start the following new Academic Programs in Self-Finance mode.

(a) B.Tech in Sustainable Energy Systems

The B.Tech in Sustainable Energy Systems will be an interdisciplinary program with participation of EE, CH and ME Departments. The admission shall be through JEE Mains.

(a) BS degree in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science

It is proposed to start a new UG program, Four-year Bachelor of Science in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science. Further, it is proposed that for admission into this program students are not required to obtain a rank in JEE Mains. The admission will be based on a written test conducted by the Institute.

The Senate in principle approved the proposal. The Senate requested the Chairman, New Academic Programs, to present the names of the programs, detailed guidelines, the modalities for admission such as conduction of test and syllabi in the next Senate meeting.

2025-141-Senate-6	Proposal for Starting Department of Education
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ITEP has been started in few IITs and NITS including NIT Warangal since 2023. Currently this program is administered by the Department of MA. It is observed that there is a lot of scope in focusing on education technology and lifelong learning in addition to BSc. BEd. Program. In view

of enhancing these activities, It is proposed to create an exclusive Department of Education.

After detailed deliberations the Senate approved the proposal.

2025-141-Senate-7	Partha Ghosh Leadership Academy
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It is proposed to establish “Partha Ghosh Leadership Academy”. The Academy will be responsible to offer leadership programs and workshops for the benefit of faculty and students. Further the Academy is expected to offer an Open Elective Course on Leadership for the benefit of students. The draft proposal for establishing the Leadership Academy is given in Annexure-1.

The Senate in principle approved the proposal and advised Prof. Harikrishna (CE) to submit a detailed proposal including financial budget and obligation from both NIT Warangal and the Academy.

2025-141-Senate-8	Joint PG programs in Collaboration with AIT Bangkok
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Prof. C.S.R.K. Prasad, former Dean (IRAA) and Prof. Shirish H. Sonawane, Dean (R&D), recently visited Asian Institute of Technology Bankkok to attend the Industry Academia International Business Incubation Conclave (INAIBIC 2024) at AIT Bangkok.

Based on the visit and preliminary discussions, it is proposed to run joint programs with AIT Thailand in similar lines to IIT Gandhinagar. Some of the possibilities to offer joint programs are as follows:

- *B Tech (3.5 years at NITW + 1.5 years at AIT) / (3 years at NITW + 1 years at AIT)*
- *BTech (4 years at NITW + 1 year management program at AIT)*
- *Dual Degree (4 years at NITW + 1 year M.Tech at AIT)*
- *MS/M.Tech (1 year at NITW + 1 year at AIT) GATE is not mandatory*
- *PG Programs (1 year at AIT + 1 year at NITW)*
- *Joint Ph.D. Programs*

The Senate discussed in detail and in principle approved the proposal for internationalization of the academic programs with following priority.

1. **B.Tech (4 years at NITW) + 1 Year Management program at AIT Bangkok**
2. **B Tech (3 years at NITW + 1 year at AIT during third year)**
3. **PG Programs (1 year at AIT + 1 year at NITW)**
4. **Joint Ph.D. Programs**

The Dean (Academic) is advised to submit detailed proposal, discussing with our alumnus, Prof. Nithin Tripathi, AIT Bangkok.

2025-141-Senate-9	PG Diploma in Computer Applications
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The Department of CS is proposing to issue an exit degree in line with NEP for MCA students. It is proposed to award PG Diploma in Computer Applications at the end of two years after successfully completing the credit requirements of first two years as suggested in the Curriculum.

The Senate discussed the above proposal and is of the opinion that instead of discussing individual exit proposals, a detailed Exit Policy of the Institute is to be formulated inviting recommendations from the NEP Committee of the Institute as per NEP-2020 guidelines.

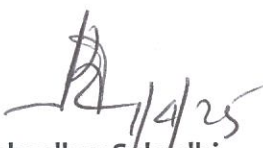
