33.5: 1 st phase of renovation work of 11 th Hostel Block is completed successfully within the ECV of Tender. Successfully and the e-Tenders will be called shortly for the 2 nd phase of renovation.

34.3	To consider and approve Conceptual Drawings for the proposed construction of five Hostel Blocks and one Kitchen & Dining Block in the Rudrama Devi Ladies Hostel Complex (RDLHC).
	In the month of October, 2020, Hon'ble Minister of Education laid Foundation Stone, virtually, for the proposed constructions in RDLHC. A 3-D walk through of the five hostel blocks was also presented based on the conceptual drawings.
	At present, Institute has a total capacity to accommodate 670 girl students in the existing three Hostels as against the present student strength of around 1200. In view of the shortage, 12 th Block (48 DS rooms) meant for boys, is being used temporarily for girls. Further, 3 students are forced to stay in DS Rooms. Some rooms of Visitor's Block, Guest House and some vacant Staff Quarters are also being used to accommodate the girl students.
1	At present the total strength of students is around 6,200. As part of NEP-2020, the strength is likely to increase to around 10,000 in coming years as medium-term plan. Assuming around 20% of them will be girl students and stay in the Campus, the Institute needs to plan for

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accommodating 2,000 girl students.

To augment the capacity by constructing new hostels, the **vacant** land space adjacent to (towards East) the existing ladies' hostels is earmarked for creating additional accommodation, dining and other facilities for girl students. The entire space, the existing & conceived, is named as **Rudrama Devi Ladies Hostel Complex (RDLHC)**.

Two versions of conceptual drawings were submitted.

remaining works may be decided in the FC.

Resolution

The Committee resolved to approve the conceptual drawings for the proposed construction of (i) **One** 2-seater Block (G+9) accommodating 664 students, (ii) **Four** 1-seater Blocks (G+9), with each Block accommodating 156 students and (iii) **One** Kitchen-cum-Dining Facility (G+3) as per Version-2 (considering the advantages of Version-2) in the Rudrama Devi Ladies Hostel Complex (RDLHC).

The Committee further recommended preparation of DPR along with Estimates by CPWD based on conceptual drawings

In view of the severe shortage of and ever-increasing requirements for accommodation of girl students, the Committee felt that the Institute should give utmost priority to the project.
