action taken report on the decisions of the 35th meeting of the BWC held on 11.09.2021.

With regard to delegation of powers has recommended by the 34th meeting of BWC held on 03.03.2021, the Committee was informed that the Finance Committee and the Board of Governors have informed that as per the general principle of delegation of powers, the delegation of powers made by the BoG to BWC and the Director of the Institute may not be further delegated to other authorities. Accordingly, it has been decided not to pursue the matter and the BWC will function within the powers delegated earlier.

CONSIDER AND RECOMMEND THE TO 36.3 CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SHEDS FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND LIQUID WASTE The MANAGEMENT LABS AT NIT WARANGAL

NITW has started M Tech in Waste Management Program in 2020 and field laboratories are planned to establish pilot scale models i.e. treatment of solid waste mainly composting, aerobic digestion, anaerobic digestion, RBC, filters, constructed wetlands etc. In this regard two separate labs (30mx35m each) catering to the needs of liquid and solid wastes are proposed.

As per the draft Preliminary Estimate prepared CPWD, the expenditure is likely to be Rs.2,90,67,367/-(Rupees two crore ninety lakh sixty-seven thousand three hundred sixty-seven) including 3% contingencies. The rates are based on DPAR 2021 and DSR 2021 with up to date correction slips.

Committee considered and resolved to recommend approval of the preliminary estimate of Rs.2,90,67,367/including 3% contingencies for the construction of New Sheds for Solid Waste Management and Liquid Waste Management Labs at NIT Warangal.

36.4 TO CONSIDER AND RECOMMEND REPAIR AND LAYING OF SURFACE COURSE WITH BITUMEN OVER EXISTING ROADS IN SOUTH CAMPUS.

The existing BT roads in the college campus are damaged and deteriorated the surface course. These roads were re-carpeted previously in 2014 through CPWD with an amount of Rs.2.06 Crores.

Now, it is proposed to repair the damaged bitumen roads through CPWD. Accordingly, CPWD have submitted the draft Preliminary Estimate amounting to Rs.2,63,93,500/- (Rupees two crore sixty three lakh ninety three thousand five hundred only) including 3% contingencies.

The Committee suggested to cover all the roads of the campus as it will ensure uniform thickness and avoid patch works.

The Committee considered and resolved to recommend repair and laying of surface course with Bitumen over existing roads, and to obtain the approval of FC/BoG on the revised estimates, to be obtained from CPWD.

36.5 TO CONSIDER AND RECOMMEND SPECIAL REPAIRS TO LIBRARY BLOCK FOR NIT WARANGAL.

The existing library building (G+2) was constructed in the year 1998 and requires immediate attention for repair and renovation. Owing to the age of building, cracks have been observed on the slabs, spalling of concrete, seepage stains, water leaking through RCC slab, damaged false ceiling due to seepage, corroded MS window frames etc. The electrical fittings also require immediate attention from safety point of view.

Now, it is proposed to repair the library building through CPWD. Accordingly, CPWD have submitted the draft Preliminary Estimate amounting to Rs.3,78,19,541/-(Rupees Three Crores seventy eighty lakhs nineteen thousand five hundred and forty one only) including 3% contingencies.

The main civil items covered in the estimate are replacement of windows, false ceiling, repairs to plinth protection, Water proofing to roof top, painting etc. The electrical items are wiring, BLDC fans & LED lights, DBs & MCBs, cabling, Earthing, Manual fire alarm system, VRF AC system, etc.

The Committee considered and resolved to recommend approval for special repairs to Library Block through CPWD for an estimate of Rs.3,78,19,541/- including 3% contingencies.

36.6 TO CONSIDER AND RECOMMEND HOUSEKEEPING SERVICES FOR HALLS OF RESIDENCE FOR 1.8K, 1.0K, DASA, 12TH BLOCK, 14TH BLOCK & GIRLS HOSTEL FOR PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS AT NIT WARANGAL

The estimate of housekeeping services for halls of residence for 1.8K, 1.0K, DASA, 12th block, 14th block & Girls hostel for period of 12months at NIT Warangal was prepared for an amount of Rs.3,00,00,000/-(Rupees three crore).

The total circulation area of 42,451Sqm, Carpet area of 72,837Sqm, Total toilet units are 1503 No's and Techno sweeping area of 47,700Sqm. The estimate was prepared for one year and shall be extended with same rates for further one more year.

The Committee recommended to tender the work initially for a period of two years extendable by one more year. It was also suggested to include a tender condition to provide for payment of difference in the minimum wages of the minimum number of manpower after one year of the contract, to avoid manipulations by the contractors and resultant litigation. Accordingly, the estimated cost of the work may be revised and submitted to the FC/BoG for approval.

The Committee considered and recommended for tendering the work of Housekeeping services initially for a period of two years extendable by one more year as per the revised estimates.

CONSIDER AND RECOMMEND RATE 36.7 **TO** CONTRACT FOR ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OF The Committee recommended CIVIL NATURE OF WORKS FOR COLLEGE entering into the rate contract BUILDINGS, STAFF QUARTERS AND HOSTEL BUILDINGS AT NIT WARANGAL

The estimate for routine maintenance of civil nature works for college buildings, staff quarters and hostel buildings at NIT Warangal was prepared for an amount of Rs.1,70,00,000/- (Rupees one crore seventy lakh). The estimate was prepared based on DSR 2021 and local market rates.

The estimate covered like brick masonry, plastering, painting, flooring tiles, water proofing, false ceiling, Aluminum partitions, termite control, concreting, paver blocks, carpentry items etc. and the period of contract will be one year.

The estimate is placed before the BWC to consider and accord in principle approval for calling e-tenders through E&MU office. Director may be authorized to finalize the tender.
