5.	Reducing the minimum period after Ph.D. for recognition as Research Supervisor. As per the regulations a faculty member with Post Ph.D. experience of 2 years is eligible to be recognized as a research supervisor. Some of the Senators have given a representation to reduce this minimum period of two years for recognizing the faculty members as research supervisors.	It is resolved that the regular faculty members with Ph.D. can be recognized as a research supervisors and can be allotted Ph.D. scholars.

Senate has approved the following items subject to ratification by the Senate.	
(1) Conversion of Ph.D. registration from Full time to Part time in respect of Mr. G. Rajamouli, Ph.D. scholar in the Department of Civil Engineering.	Ratified
(2) Modifications in the eligibility criteria for admission into Ph.D. program for the Part-time candidates. The requirement of having 2/4 papers in journals of repute is deleted. Further, project associates with ME/M.Tech. qualification in National Research Institutes having MOU with NITW were also made eligible.	Ratified
(3) Modifications in grading for Makeup examination:	
Candidates who have registered under study mode during the academic year and have appeared for the makeup examination are to be graded according to the study mode grading applicable to the regular batch of students. In case they get an F grade, it is proposed that the students who get 30% or more (in case of UG), 40% or more (in case of PG) marks in the makeup examination be awarded P grade by treating them as registered under examination mode. This revised rules is applicable prospectively for all makeup examinations starting from July, 2013.	Ratified

Joint supervisor from other higher learning institutes for internal Ph.D. scholars:

As per the existing practices, the internal research scholars (full time / part time) cannot have a joint supervisor from other educational institutes. The Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering has proposed a modification to have a joint supervisor (for internal Ph.D. scholars) from other higher learning institutes.

- iii. The following Ph.D. Scholars have completed their permissible period of registration of 6 years and have not completed their work. In the 56th meeting Senate has permitted the Internal Faculty members who have registered for Ph.D. under Part time and have not completed their work within the stipulated maximum period were permitted for re-admission with a new roll number. If a similar permission is extended to other full time / part time scholars, they have to pay the entire admission fee of Rs. 20,750/- as a fresh scholar with a new roll number.

- iv. Non-completion of course work of Mr. C. Satyanarayana Raju, MED:
- Two candidates from M.Sc. Chemistry got less than 6.00 CGPA at the end of the IV Semester. As per the regulations they are not eligible for award of the degree.
- vi. Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering has put up a proposal for relaxing the eligibility criteria for admission into Ph.D. (part time) in terms of the experience: from 5 years to 3 years in case of M.Tech. and 10 years to 6 years in case of B.Tech. The department also has recommended a minimum of one research publication in peer-reviewed journals.

To allow Joint Supervisor from other higher learning Institutes for internal research scholars based on the recommendations of DSC and DAC-PG&R of the respective Department.


