(Tech) (excepting III year I semester Photonics), B.Tech. examinations conducted during November 2013 and I, II, V and VI quarters of MBA are discussed and approved. To review the grades of II B.Tech. Electronics and Communication Engineering in the subjects NTL and DSD.</li><li>5. To review the grades of I B.Tech. in the subject Chemistry Lab (CY102).</li></ol> <p>The Senate authorized the Chairman to approve the results of the programmes not presented to the Senate and the modified results in the subjects as suggested above.</p> <p>In this context Senate has suggested</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) to have a Heads and Deans meeting for reviewing the grades submitted by the respective DACs before presenting to the Senate.</li><li>(ii) that the Departments avoid scheduling any workshops during the evaluation period (positively) and during the examinations (to the extent possible).</li></ol> <p>Senate directed all the Heads of the Departments that the presentation of results of the examinations conducted cannot be delayed for any reason.</p> <p>Senate approved to with held the results of I B.Tech. students with Roll Nos. 921315 and 921322 till in the recommendations of the malpractice committee are submitted.</p>

1.	Change of titles of M.Sc. Chemistry Programmes.	<p>Deferred to the next Senate. In the context it is also suggested that the change of the name of M.Tech. (Information Security) and M.Tech. programmes in Mechanical Engineering Department be also presented to the next Senate.</p> <p>It is suggested to have a Senate sub-committee to consider the possibility of starting new programmes / modifying existing programmes in the Science Departments.</p>
2.	Representation from PG Students to indicate absolute grading in their grade sheets.	Approved to include the Absolute Grading Status in the Grade Sheets of all PG programmes commencing from the current semester grade sheets
3.	Representation from the students regarding the award of division for the students whose CGPA is less than 6.0.	It is resolved to refer this issue to the committee to be constituted regarding Grading Scheme for the PG students.
4.	Promotion of students who complete the Academic requirements at the end of I semester for promotion to the next academic year.	It is resolved that any promotion to the next year of study shall be into the I semester only and hence, the request of the students to move to the II semester of their next year of study is not accepted.
5.	Representation of IV B.Tech. EEE students for conduct of evening classes in one subject in which they were awarded R Grade for shortage of attendance.	It is resolved that evening classes cannot be conducted during the next semester.
