




Before taking up the items specified in the agenda, Chairman permitted Prof N S Murthy to present Joint Review Mission of TEQIP-II project report.

Prof. N S Murthy, TEQIP-II project coordinator has placed before the Senate the information that NIT-Warangal has secured 10/10 points in the JRM meeting during the review of institute's performance in TEQIP-II. He also requested the faculty through the Senate that efforts are needed for the early compliance in case of some pending cases, such as i) submission of NBA applications; ii) other soft components.
