To consider and recommend for the work of construction of a New Ladies Hostel to accommodate 304 girl students under EWS Scheme, 2 No. of single-seated blocks (G+9 storeys each) and 1 No. of kitchen cum Dining block (G+3 floors) at NITW campus.

Resolution:

The Committee resolved to consider and recommend approval to take up the work with an estimated cost of Rs. 56.52 Crores. An amount of Rs 43.00 Crores will be sanctioned from EWS Grants and the balance of Rs. 13.52 crores will be met from the institute's funds under IRG and work may be executed through CPWD.

To consider and recommend the proposal to renovate the Old Auditorium in the Institute campus.

Resolution:

The Committee resolved to consider and recommend approval of the preliminary estimate of Rs. 6.50 Crores. However, the committee felt that Rs. 6.5 Crores may not be sufficient for the renovation. The detailed estimates from CPWD are awaited.

The work expenditure may be booked under OH-35 and the work can be done through CPWD.

May 30, 2023, Office Order No. 487/2023, and the team inspected the academic buildings and staff quarters in the south campus. A summary of the same is as follows:

SI. No	Name of Building	Year of Construction	Recommendations of the committee
1	Old Chemical and Metallurgy Building	1972	Recommended for Demolition by BAC. In this, it is proposed to construct a classroom complex.
2	Old Printing press (Partly slab & shed)	1975	Recommended for Demolition by BAC.
3	Staff Quarters A1–A12	1964, 1968 and 1995	Minor and major repairs need to be addressed.
4	Staff Quarters B1-B2	1964	Minor repairs are to be attended to.
5	48 "C" Type Staff Quarters	1964	Some of the C-type quarters can be recommended for minor or major repairs. Some quarters, like C1, C2, C3, C7, and C13, need total renovation.
5	Staff Quarters D1 and D2	1964	D1 quarter can be repaired, while D2 quarter may be demolished.

The matter is placed before the Buildings and Works Committee for its consideration and approval to dismantle/repair/renovate the above buildings.

Resolution:

The Committee resolved to consider and recommend approval for demolition/renovation as per the recommendations of Building Assessment Committee (BAC). The renovation will be carried out in a phased manner through OH-35 grant.

Agenda No. BWC-39(2023)-06:

To consider and recommend the recruitment of a Technical Assistant (Horticulture).

Resolution:

The Committee considered and resolved to recruit a Technical Assistant (Horticulturist) as the posts of Technical Assistant are available. Till the recruitment of Tech Asst on full time basis, it is decided to utilize the services of existing Horticulturist (contract basis) with Rs. 50,000/- per month.
