Instructions for the candidates who have submitted their applications for Group 'A' posts against Advertisement No. 03/2026 dated 20.07.2026

All candidates may go through the following instructions for compliance:

1. Candidature of candidates shown 'provisionally shortlisted' is purely provisional and is based on preliminary scrutiny of information provided by them. It creates no right in favour of any candidate and the Institute reserves the right to debar a candidate for further stages of recruitment, if information provided is found to be false/ incomplete.
2. Candidates who have been provisionally not shortlisted may prefer a representation to the Institute, if they feel that reason mentioned for non-eligibility does not reflect the true position. Such representation, bearing title of the subject as "Representation against Application No..... for the post of.....", citing cogent reasons along with supporting documents, may be submitted only through Email to **recruit_admn@nitw.ac.in** by 05:00 P.M., 26.08.2026, failing which their candidature shall be treated as cancelled without any further notice. No vexatious representations shall be considered and no individual query on result of consideration of such representation shall be entertained.
3. E-mails received without prescribed subject and/ or received after the prescribed date (i.e. 26.08.2026) would not be opened under any circumstances. Hard copy of communications will not be considered. The Institute shall not be responsible to candidates who could not take appropriate action due to their failure to visit the website within the stipulated time.
4. Those candidates who have applied for the posts on Deputation (ISTC) basis and provisionally shortlisted shall have to submit the following documents before or at the time of Interview:
 - a. Certified copies of APARs for the last 05 years duly attested on each page by an officer not below the rank of Under Secretary or equivalent;
 - b. Vigilance Clearance certificate;
 - c. No Objection certificate clearly indicating the method of recruitment i.e. Deputation (incl. Short Term Contract);

Failing which, their candidature is liable to be cancelled, and they will not be allowed to participate in the recruitment process.

5. All the representations would be considered and if in any case the grounds/ reasons raised by the candidates therein are found to be correct, such applications would be considered for shortlisting and the rejection of others would be maintained. However, the same would be examined only with reference to age, category, qualification, experience claimed in the Online Application. Thereafter, revised and final scrutiny details would be uploaded in the Institute website. No individual replies would be given.
