5.	The case of Mr. A.Rahul Kumar Naik, a student of Bio-Technology vide Roll No. 6837 of the Institute.	The recommendations of the DAC (UG) of Dept. of Bio-Technology were approved by the Senate and resolved to declare the result.
6.	To consider the application of Mr. Ch.T.V.D.S. Prasad, a student of M.Tech., (Geo-Tech.) vide Roll No.071113 of the Institute, to submit the dissertation work.	The Senate considered the case and observed that similar cases requesting for completion of
<p>Project work, after discontinuity, exist. In all such cases it was decided that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(1) only candidates who have completed the stipulated course work and had to discontinue further course of study due to reasons of ill-health / employment reasons, etc., would be considered for registration / permission to complete the project / Dissertation work.</li><li>(2) a penal processing fee of Rs.5,000/- is required to be paid along with application for re-registration.</li><li>(3) the candidate should deposit the entire stipend paid, while on rolls, to the Institute.</li><li>(4) the candidates who have returned the stipend paid to them, will be allowed to register from the ensuing semester. The amount of stipend due to the candidate for the period of full-semesters present, before discontinuity, will be paid back after qualifying for the award of the Degree.</li><li>(5) the candidates would be waived of the residential requirement provided they register for double the period of normal requirement. Only on completion of this time requirement the candidate will be permitted to submit his project / Dissertation work.</li><li>(6) the maximum period for completion of the programme would be extended by one more year i.e., five years for M.Tech.</li><li>(7) to identify similar unreported cases of M.Tech., students who have completed the course work but could not take-up project / dissertation work for the reasons of ill-health / getting employment / etc. The Head of the Departments are to communicate such list of eligible candidates to the Dean (AA) by 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2011 so as to place it before the next Senate.</li></ol>
