

3.5	<p>Case of M.Tech. Manufacturing Engineering student (Name: G. S. Pramod Krishna Roll No : 123506)</p> <p>Mr. G.S. Pramod Krishna, Roll No. 123506 who was admitted into M.Tech 1-year (Manufacturing Engineering) in the Department of Mechanical Engineering during the academic year 2012-13 has completed the I and II Semesters as a full time student at the Institute. For the Dissertation work in III semester he has been sent to CMTI, Bangalore.</p> <p>Based on the progress reports recommended by the Head of the Department of Mechanical Engineering, his stipend @ 8000/- per month was paid for a period of 24 months i.e. from July, 2012 to June, 2014.</p> <p>When contacted in June 2014 for his Dissertation Part B examination by the guide and he told the guide that the work was not complete and he needs extension. He also informed that he joined CMTI in Feb 2014.</p> <p>The institute received a letter on 10.11.2014 from CMTI informing that he is drawing salary from Feb 2014 and also stipend from the institute. The institute formed an enquiry committee and suggested him to pay the salary to the CMTI Bangalore. The candidate paid the amount to the CMTI and submitted the receipt to the Institute.</p> <p>DAC-PG & R meeting held on 26.11.2014 has observed the following recommendations and forward to the Dean (Academic)</p>	Defered.



1. Mr. G. S. Pramod Krishna (Roll No. 123506) was sent to CMTI, Bangalore to do his dissertation work in the month of July 2013.
2. The dissertation work was supposed to be completed by the month of June 2014. The candidate was regularly informing his guide about the progress made in his dissertation work over phone.
3. The guide called the candidate to submit the thesis in the month of June 2014 and the candidate informed that the work was not completed and he requires extension. The candidate also informed that he joined CMTI as an Apprentice Officer (APO). The guide immediately advised the student to apply for converting his registration from regular to part-time mode.
4. Officially, the Department has no knowledge of candidate's appointment as APO and also drawing of stipend (Rs. 25,000) from CMTI until the receipt of the letter from CMTI dated 10.11.2014.
5. Till date, the candidate neither submitted the thesis work nor requested for extension and conversion to part-time category.

The candidate did not register from Dec 2014 to till date. Now the candidate has submitted an application stating that, CMTI has given NOC and requesting to permit him to submit the thesis.

	Again DAC-PG & R meeting was held on 01.07.2016 and recommended to the Dean (Academic) to give approval for conduct of Dissertation Part B examination. The request letter and the recommendation of the HOD were received on 05.08.2016.
