## Guidelines for Physical Reporting and Classwork

All the students except I-Year B.Tech. are hereby informed that the classwork will begin offline from the next semester, i.e. Jan. 2022. The following are the guidelines for physical reporting to the campus in a phased manner:

You are requested to visit the institute website for any updates from time to time in this regard.

### Physical reporting protocols for the students:

- The registration for the next semester will be online as per the schedule given in the Academic Calendar.
- All students have to follow the “Covid-19 Protocols” and submit an undertaking endorsed by the parents along with a documentary evidence of vaccination at the time of physical reporting in the Hostel office. Format for the **undertaking by the Student and Parent/Guardian** can be [downloaded](#).
- Students who have taken at least one dose of vaccination will only be permitted to come to the Institute. Second dose of vaccination may be arranged by the institute if required.
- RT-PCR test negative report is mandatory for entering the campus, test to be taken within 72 hours before reporting to the campus, including the day of reaching.
- All the students have to wear MASK and maintain social distancing while moving in the campus. Failure will be treated seriously entailing imposition of a fine up to Rs. 1000/- on each occasion.
- All students reaching campus need to follow the institute Standard operating Protocols. ([https://www.nitw.ac.in/media/uploads/Covid\\_SOPNITW\\_Modified\\_05062020\\_Final.pdf](https://www.nitw.ac.in/media/uploads/Covid_SOPNITW_Modified_05062020_Final.pdf))
- Students will have to undergo 7 days of quarantine in the hostel after reporting/returning to the campus.
- During the quarantine period, moving around the hostel premises and meeting personally with other students/friends is strictly prohibited.
- If a student has any symptoms of ill-health, he/she must not attend physical classes. Instead he/she should report to the Institute Dispensary at the earliest.
- If any student repeatedly violates the above rules and regulations, he/she will be sent back to home or necessary action will be initiated.
- Parents will not be allowed to accompany the student inside the campus.
- A detailed step-by-step procedure for reporting will be notified by the hostel office.
- Students may be permitted to attend classes physically after completion of the quarantine period.

**Physical reporting of all the students except First year B.Tech. and Int. M.Sc. is mandatory as per the schedule mentioned below:**

The students shall **mandatorily** report to the Hostels during the dates mentioned above in order to accommodate students reporting under different phases and

**maintain the Quarantine for a period of ONE WEEK.**

**The classwork for the next semester will be conducted in Hybrid mode until further notification:**

- About 50% of the students of a class in (on a rotation basis as decided by the department) will be attending classes in online/offline mode (Hybrid mode). A hybrid mode of lecturing is used for conducting classes simultaneously for both, the students attending a class in-person and those attending in virtual mode. Those who are physically present in the class can attend a lecture and interact as usual, while those who are away can participate remotely in virtual mode accessing the live stream of the lecture.
- All the laboratory classes will be conducted offline.
- All the examinations will be conducted offline.
- Maintaining Social Distancing and Wearing Masks are MANDATORY at all times for the students while attending Classes physically.
- The Windows of all classrooms are OPENED during the class sessions to avoid the spread of virus.
