Subject: Suspension of academic, extra-curricular and co-curricular activities

In view of the current situation in the country the following measures are implemented in the Institute with immediate effect :

- i) All academic activities including classes and laboratory instructions are suspended till April 3, 2020. The situation will be reviewed continuously and appropriate decision on resumption of class work will be intimated through NITW website.
- ii) All students are encouraged to go home. In case a student wants to go home, he or she must inform the Warden of the Hostel, before leaving. However, students having any difficulty in traveling may stay back. International students are welcome to stay back in the hostels. All the students staying back in the campus are required to take adequate precautions and preventive measures, as notified by the Ministry of Health and the Institute from time to time.
- iii) Ph.D. and 2nd year PG students engaged in thesis work may continue to stay in the campus and work towards their projects if they wish, provided they take adequate precautions and preventive measures, as notified by the Ministry of Health and the Institute from time to time.
- iv) Those students who are away from the campus for any reason are advised to stay at their respective homes, instead of returning to the campus. In case any of the students/faculty and staff members or their relatives have returned to campus recently (within the last 14 days) from any of the affected countries, they must necessarily report to Institute Dispensary for a health check up immediately.
- v) All the Departments, Sections of the Administration, Accounts, Academic Sections, etc. will remain open. Faculty members may avail their vacation during the period, as per their entitlement. All non-teaching staff are required to attend to their duties as usual.

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- vi) All programmes/Conferences/Seminars/FDPs/Workshops, etc. and sports and cultural activities in the campus are also suspended with immediate effect till April 3, 2020.
- vii) Indoor sports facilities, including Gymnasium will also remain closed during the above period.
- viii) Outsourced workers and all employees of various other entities/vendors in the campus must follow the same guidelines as specified for campus residents.
- ix) Security personnel at entry points are being instructed to wear masks and hand gloves.
- x) All persons entering the campus must display their respective I-Cards.
- xi) All campus residents are requested to limit their outings to essentials only.
- xii) All campus residents are requested to avoid inviting outside guests during this period.
- xiii) All are requested to follow all health advisories as published by Government and help the campus in preventing the spread of the viral infection inside.
- xiv) All gatherings of more than ten persons for any public/private function are not allowed in the campus during the above period.

All are requested to note that all decisions will be displayed in the official web-site of the Institute only and the Institute does not take responsibility for information from any other source.

All are requested to cooperate.
