About NIT Warangal and Warangal Town:

National Institute of Technology, Warangal (NITW) formerly known as Regional Engineering College, Warangal (RECW) is the first among the 20 RECs setup as joint venture of the Government of India and State Government. Over the years, the college has established itself as a premier institution imparting technical education of high standards, leading to the B. Tech. degrees in various branches of Engineering, M. Tech. and Ph.D programs in different specializations. With a view to give further impetus to the technical education, the Central Government upgraded the RECs to NITs, and conferred the Institute of National Importance status. Warangal is known for its rich historical and cultural heritage. It is situated at a distance of 140 km from Hyderabad. Warangal is well connected by rail and road. The campus is 2 km away from Kazipet railway junction and 12 km away from Warangal railway station. Participants are advised to alight at Kazipet or Warangal depending upon the train of travel.

Introduction:

Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes have been given certain constitutional safeguards for their welfare to facilitate speedier social restructuring and building of a humane and harmonious Indian society. Government of India's standing Instruction that Reservation at the prescribed percentages for SC, ST and OBCs should invariably be made to the extent stipulated in all the

posts filled by direct recruitment and in posts filled by promotion unless any posts are exempted by special or general instructions issued by the Department of Personnel and Training (DOPT). This instruction derives its strength from the Articles 16(4), 335, 341 and 342 of the Constitution of India.

In a multiple undulating society like ours, early achievement of the objective of social justice as enshrined in the Constitution is a MUST. With this purpose in view, certain weightage has to be provided to such classes in the services of the Union and their Public Undertakings.

Theme of the Workshop:

Implementation of roster systems in Central/State government organizations as per the Government of India rules and regulations. It is also focused on the reservation policies in promotions and direct recruitments.
