### **B. Instructions to students of terminal semester online examinations:**

1. Attendance to end semester examination for terminal semester is compulsory. The candidate will be awarded F grade (irrespective of his / her performance in Minor(s) / Mid examinations) if he / she remains absent for end semester examination for terminal semester. The candidate is required to inform to the concerned course coordinator about his / her absence in the examination and the reasons thereof.
2. Students are requested to check their network connection and be available at the location where basic network connectivity will be available during the examination. Keep back up for internet source (for ex. Hotspot in mobile), laptop/mobile, charging/UPS/Inverter, etc.
3. The CRs of every class are advised to share the mobile number and email id of all the eligible students to appear in the exams with the respective course coordinator in an excel sheet.

4. Login using your registered Gmail ID only, for accessing the Google forms. In case of any queries in the question paper during the examination, contact the course coordinator. Do not attempt to interact with any of the students during the examination.
5. Never refresh the Google form during the examination (you lose all entered data). Before clicking the submit button please make sure that you have an active internet connection to avoid loss of entered data.
6. Students are advised to keep the alarm in their devices as a reminder to submit the examination forms. This is required to avoid any unwarranted delays in submission.
7. Students under the PWD category will be given extra time of 5 minutes for the submission of examination forms of objective and descriptive papers independently.
8. In case of any practical difficulties/issues (power failure, loss of internet, etc.) leading to halt of examination, report the event immediately to the respective teacher of the course coordinator over Email/mobile.
9. All the **answer sheets (A4)** to be marked with the **page number, roll number, name, date and signature of student on the top of every page**. Please have sufficient stock of A4 size papers/graph papers. Make complete use of space in the A4 sheets and minimize the use of sheets. This is to ensure faster upload of the combined PDF copy.
10. Practice and use a suitable scanner app (e.g. Adobe Scan, Microsoft Office Lens, etc.) for scanning and generating a legible combined PDF copy of the answer sheets (single file). Total **PDF** file size to be uploaded should be less than or around **10 MB** (preferably) and **file to be named with the roll number**.
11. The scanned file shall be mailed to the concerned teacher of the course immediately within the given time. The concerned teacher allotted to the student will acknowledge the receipt of the scanned answer sheet to the individual students on email / WhatsApp. In case, after submission, an acknowledgement is not received by 6.00 pm on the same day of exam, the student must contact the concerned teacher.
12. If any student found involved in any unfair means of activity (a few of them are listed below), the course coordinators will take the appropriate decision, in consultation with the respective HoD.
  - a) Delay in submission of the Google form (based on the timestamp) beyond the permissible duration prescribed in the question paper.
  - b) Non-submission of the Google form and / or scanned copy of the answer sheets, i.e. abandoning the examination without any communication and valid reason.
  - c) Sharing / uploading full or part of the scanned copies of the answer sheets with other students, during or after the examination through Email, WhatsApp, or other platforms.
  - d) Proxy submission.
13. Any other activity that dampens the spirit of the examination. All relevant rules not specified here but are given in the rule book are also applicable.
14. Students are instructed to regularly visit NITW home page (<https://www.nitw.ac.in>) time-to-time and be in regular contact with the department, HoD, subject teachers to check for further instructions released regarding the conduct of the examination.
